Optional field trips are also available for prekindergarten campers only.
- **Mini Camp:** Children entering preschool or prekindergarten New this summer, mini-camps are special camp experiences for campers who do not need a full-time camp, but would like to participate in some fun activities. Mini camps are half-day programs for three and four year-olds offered in July and August. Families can pick the days and weeks that work with their summer schedules.

General Information

Summer '11 vacation

- Children participating in any Holding Hands Summer Vacation program must register for a minimum of two weeks throughout the summer and for at least two days in any one week.
- Field trips are generally scheduled for Wednesdays. A tentative schedule of trips is enclosed. PreK campers may attend some field trips. However, if your school-aged child is scheduled to attend on a field trip day, he/she must participate in the field trip. No school-aged camper can remain behind at the center.
- Tuition is due weekly and may be paid by cash, check or credit card (MasterCard, VISA and American Express). Once enrolled, tuition is due even if the camper does not attend because of illness or other reasons. There are limited opportunities to switch weeks if the space is available. Additional weeks may be added after initial registration, if space is available.
- The full-day camp program is provided from 7:00am to 6:00pm. The half-day program is from 8:30am to 12:30pm. If you need an earlier drop-off or later pick-up, please check the box on the Registration Form and you will be contacted with more information.
- After processing your registration, we will provide a written confirmation of your camper's enrollment along with additional forms to complete and a statement of total camp charges.



About Fees & Discounts:

Registration Fee: There is a one-time \$65 registration fee for the first camper and \$50 for each additional sibling. If your child has participated in our camp program before or is currently enrolled at Holding Hands, this fee is waived. This fee is non-refundable.

Tuition: Tuition is due weekly and is based on the number of days for which a child is registered in

that week. A \$150 Camp Deposit per child is required at registration (applied to the Summer Activity Fee and the final week of tuition). This Deposit will only be refunded if requested prior to June 1, 2011.

Summer Activity Fee: The Activity Fee covers the cost of all special events and activities. This Fee is paid as part of the Camp Deposit due at registration.

Field Trip Fee: All school-aged campers who register for a field trip day must participate in field trips. This field trip fee is paid in one total payment due by June 20th. Your camper cannot start camp until this fee is paid.

Discounts

- **Early Registration Discount:** If your registration is postmarked by May 23, 2011, there is a 20% discount on the first week's tuition.
- **Monthly Payment Discount:** If you enroll your child for six or more weeks, you may pay tuition, in advance on a monthly basis, with a discount (2.5% by check, 1% by credit card).
- **Sibling Discount:** There is a 7% discount on tuition charges for each additional child if the children are enrolled for four or more weeks and four or more days each week.

Discounts do not apply to the Summer Activity, Field Trip or Registration Fees.

Refund Policy

- The Registration Fee is non-refundable. There are also no refunds for absences.
- The \$150 Camp Deposit (credited to the Activity Fee and Tuition) can be refunded, if requested by June 1, 2011. After June 1st, no refunds will be given.
- The Field Trip Fee is non-refundable. In cases of trip cancellation or rescheduling, partial refunds will be available upon request.

To Register:

- ✓ Complete the enclosed Registration Form selecting the program, weeks and days you desire.
- ✓ Return the Registration Form via mail or fax along with the Registration Fee (if applicable) and Camp Deposit.

You will receive a confirmation of enrollment.
